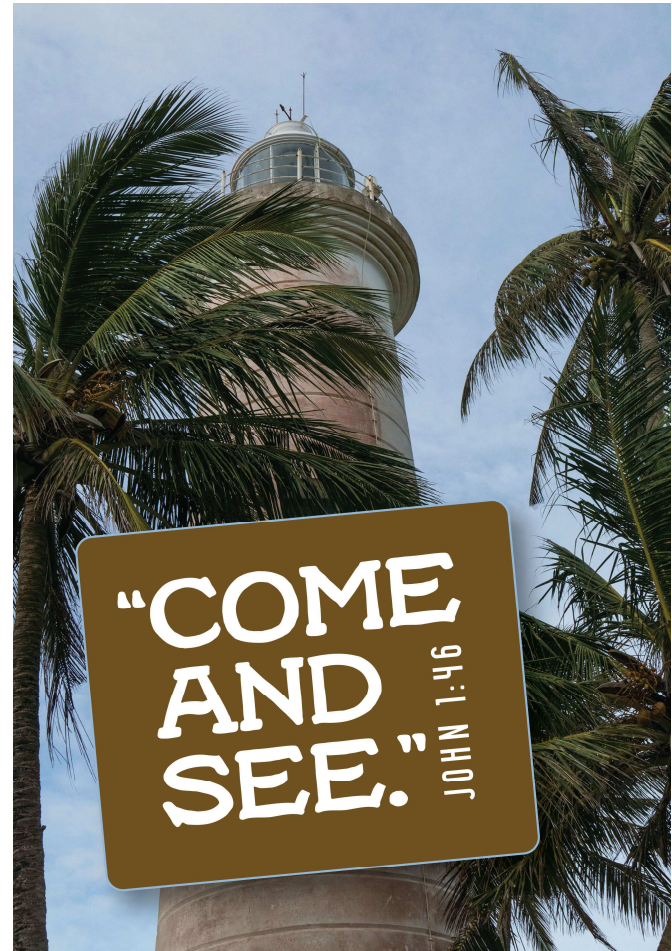

This Summer pastor Luke is looking to take Middle and High School Students to Savannah, Georgia for a week-long mission project with Youth-Works. There are spots for 8 students on a first-come, first serve basis. *If needed and available, we can add slots for additional students.*

Dates: June 27-July 3

Cost: ~\$400 : *depending on fundraising goals. Scholarships will be available.*

We will begin the trip by traveling to Washington, DC to visit the brand new "Museum of the Bible," stay a night in DC, then travel down to Savannah on June 28.

While in Georgia, our group will have the opportunity to do hands-on work projects, partner with local ministries and non-profit organizations that serve seniors, children and those experiencing homelessness. In the evenings, we will get to have dinner each night, an evening to swim at Tybee Island, we will learn about historic injustices by touring a church involved with the underground railroad, take a stroll through the Riverwalk and other tourist destinations in Savannah, and end the week with a community cookout celebration.
