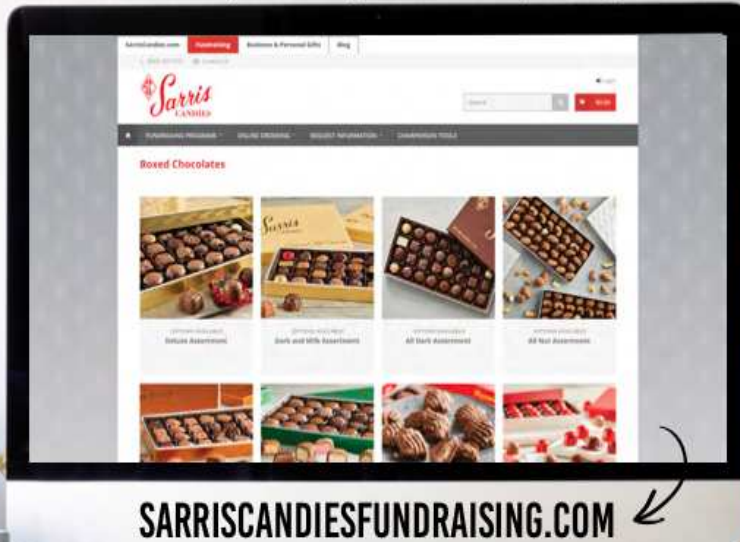

DIGGing Deeper will begin a study of 1 Corinthians. At the time he wrote this letter to the young church in Corinth, Paul had moved to Ephesus where he would spend the next three years. He had heard reports of several types of problems with the church; difficulty leaving behind their pagan ways and becoming separated into factions based upon leadership. Paul spends a good portion of the letter attempting to correct these behaviors. He also writes about the doctrines of Christianity. Today we find ourselves exposed to many of the behaviors Paul challenged the Corinthians to renounce. Factions exist in our denomination. 1 Corinthians is just as relevant now as in the 1st century.
