

That phrase is used often, sometimes in conflicting ways, to explain events we don't understand. During World War II Leslie Weatherhead was the pastor of City Temple in London. After the church was destroyed by the constant bombing by the Germans, Weatherhead preached a series of 5 sermons to help his parishioners understand how the will of God related to the bombings. The sermons were so helpful Weatherhead, at the request of others, published the sermons. His writing is easily understood even though this can be a heavy theological concept. The book has been required reading in seminaries. Weatherhead explains 3 different types of God's will using the life of Jesus as an example.
